- 1 Pear (sliced)
- 2 Large Bananas (peeled and sliced)
- 3 Kiwi Fruit (peeled and sliced into rounds)
- 3 Clementines (peeled and separated)
- ¹/₂ cup Pomegranate Seeds
- 1 tablespoon Honey
- 3 tablespoons Lime Juice
- 1 tablespoon Poppy Seeds
- 1 tablespoons Fresh Mint (chopped)
- 1. Combine: In a large bowl place the apple, pear, bananas, kiwi, clementines and pomegranate seeds. Stir gently.
